Key Areas of Responsibility:

In coordination with other crew members the LHD Operator follows job procedures and regulations to perform one of the tasks required in the Mine Project process. He/she will haul muck or materials as required.

General Duties and Responsibilities:

- Work in compliance with all Health & Safety rules and regulations for Cementation and the Client
- Be aware and report any health and safety hazards or infractions to your supervisor
- Oversee material handling and secure loads, including equipment preparation, application of safe practices, compliance with applicable Acts and Regulations
- Perform trip inspections on equipment operated and load, ensuring safety and roadworthiness
- Manoeuvre trucks into loading or unloading positions, following signals from loading crew as needed; check that vehicle position is correct and any special loading equipment is properly positioned
- Check vehicles before driving them to ensure that mechanical, safety, and emergency equipment is in good working order
- Report all vehicle defects, accidents and damage to your supervisor
- Record and maintain required documentation
- Ensure that any debris caused by the loading/unloading of truck is cleaned up
- Other related duties as required
